### NMR core activities:

- The Nordic Journal of Migration Research (NJMR) was founded in 2011 by NMR. It is a double-blind peer review journal with online open access publications focused on migration research from a Nordic perspective (<https://journal-njmr.org/>).
- A biannual Nordic Migration Research conference rotating between Sweden (2018), Finland (2021), Denmark (2022) and Norway (2024). The last conference, in Helsinki 2021, gathered around 700 migration scholars from Nordic countries and beyond.
- A mobility grant to support young scholars to attend the Nordic Migration Research conference.
- The Nordic Migration Research webpage function to disseminate information about NMR's and NMR Institutional Members' activities.
- The NMR Send List function to disseminate research related information and facilitate research cooperation between all Send List members (to sign up: <https://lists.utu.fi/mailman/listinfo/nmr-sendlist>).

### Institutional Membership privileges
